Actual fresh yuzu fruit are difficult to find in the US, unless you have your own tree, or one of the Japanese local grocery stores buys fruit from someone with trees in the area. I typically see these for a short time at Tokyo Fish Market in Berkeley, and sometimes at the SF Ferry building from a citrus grower when they are in season. I have had a small tree for a few years, and finally I harvested a couple of fruits, but I tend not to keep it watered (or fertilized) as well as it needs. I actually soaked the yuzu skins in a traditional hot bath (yuzu-yu), and it was fabulous.

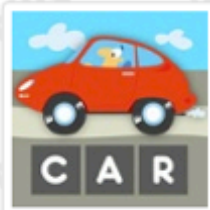
Got this as a recommendation from Bagcheck and it got the full approval up from my son. The game mirrors the big wooden puzzle he plays with at home: moving shapes into holes. There are several levels of difficulty and he can sit and play this one for 30 minutes at a time. He's progressively been moving up in difficulty to harder, layered puzzles. The game has a lot of different screens to master.

A big thumbs up for their "back" menu control -it requires a long swipe across the screen so it prevent kids form making mistakes and quitting out of their game. smart! Only wish this app came iPad native vs. iPhone only. But we play it at 2x on the iPad and it worked pretty well.

One gripe: after completing a puzzle, a new one does not show up automatically. Instead, you have to navigate to the home page and pick another puzzle. Really should keep the flow going with a new puzzle to keep toddlers entertained.

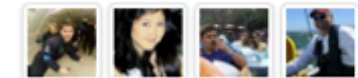
For iPad and iPhone

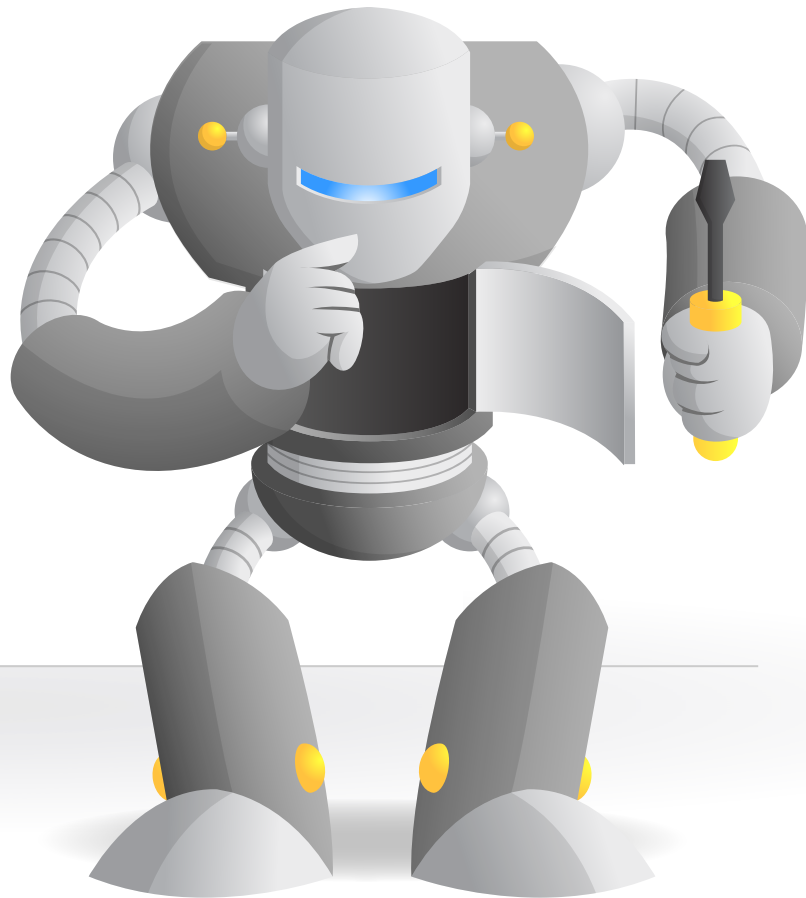

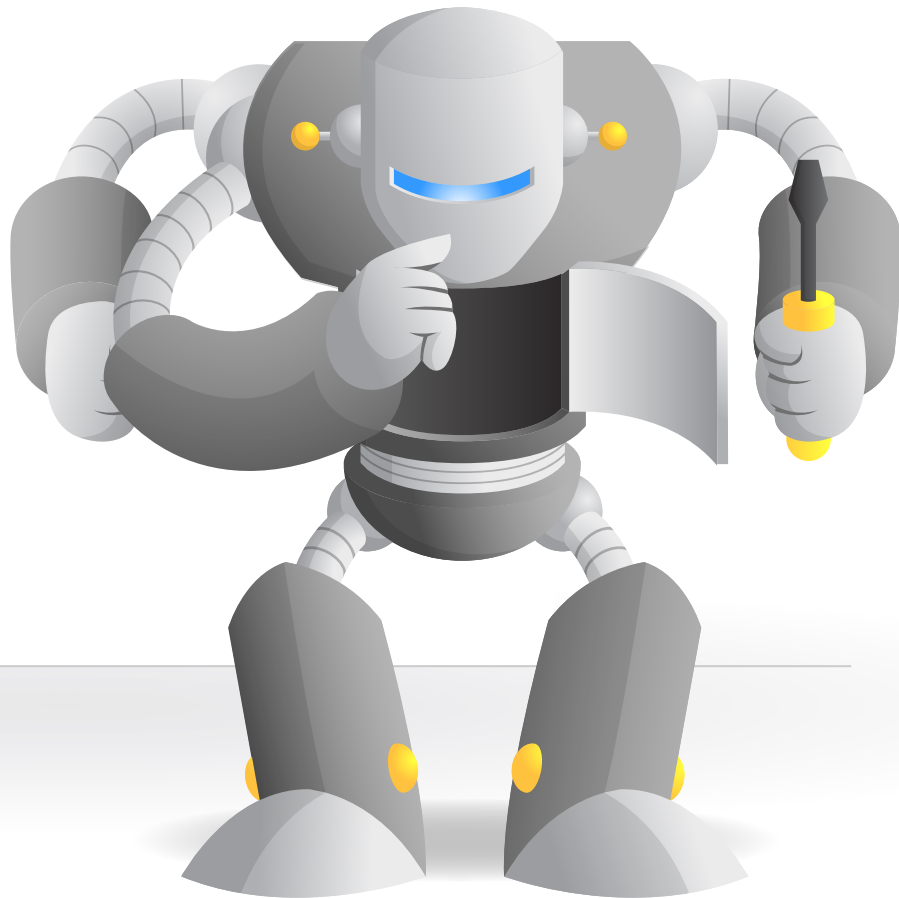

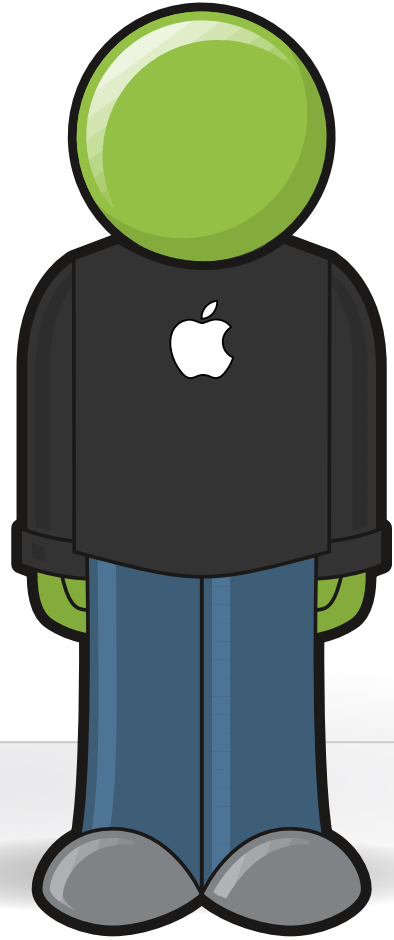
